

Shade doesn't fall directly below the shade sail. The shadow is determined by three things.

1.Time of Day
2.Laitude
3.Earths Tilt
So remember when designing shade the angle of the sun will change throughout the day
and the level of coverage will fluctuate as a result. It is essential to identify how and when
the space will be used.
So having a quit for your clients is a good starting point.
The time of day it is likely to be used (mid morning, midday, late afternoon)
How might you use it in different seasons?
Why you need coverage?
Who will take it down in bad weather?
